Tips

- 1) Place line keys (make similar on all phones) i.e. 555-5555 or Line 1
- 2) Choose keys for extension names/numbers i.e. Jamie, 108 or Jamie 108
- 3) Designate keys for Speed Dial Numbers (provide a name for the key, not a phone number)
- 4) Select keys for Special Key Feature Options some examples would be an Intercom key for paging all extensions or a Voicemail key if you have system voicemail.
